If you are NPIP certified and AI certified you DO NOT have to get AI certification again within 21 days of the show.
***** Bring all certifications with you*****

If you are only NPIP you DO have to get AI certification WITHIN 21 days of the show.

Those who are within the state of Tennessee need Pullorum testing only.
Pullorum tester will be at the show for state of Tennessee birds ONLY.

SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION & RULES

All recognized and non-standard varieties of large fowl, bantams, pigeons and water fowl are accepted in the show.

Open & Junior entry fee \$3.50 per bird (\$7.00 for double coop), plus a \$5.00 clean up fee per exhibitor.
Show entries close at midnight on November 25, 2017. There will be a \$50 late fee for entries postmarked after that date.

No phone or email entries will be accepted.

Payment must accompany ALL entries, NO exceptions! Entries will not be processed without payment. See new Tennessee State Law requirements above.

All birds deemed sick or diseased by a TVPC officer or judge will be disqualified and removed from the show. TVPC nor any of its officers will be responsible for any loss, sickness, or injury to any bird during the show; however all precautions will be taken to protect all exhibits.

All birds must be cooped in by 9:00 am on December 2nd.

Juniors will be responsible for their birds, parents are not allowed to clean or assist in any way. If junior needs help cooping birds in, a TVPC member will be glad to help them. If parents are assisting or cleaning birds the junior will be disqualified from the show.

All exhibitors and two immediate family members will receive a pass for free admission at check in. There will be a \$5.00 fee charged for all lost passes.

All Judges Decisions are final. All protests must be made in writing and accompanied by a \$25.00 deposit made to TVPC. The Show Committee will make the final decision and in the event finds no justification for the protest, the fee will be forfeited.

No person will be allowed in the aisle during judging, or allowed to talk to the judge during judging.

No vendors or sale birds will be allowed outside the show building. All sales will be held inside in the designated area only.

No cooping out before Champion of Show is chosen.

No alcohol or drugs in the show room or on the fair grounds.

Anyone caught stealing will be turned over to the police and banned for life from any show of the TVPC.

Security will be on the fair grounds 24/7.

Show will be open to the general public on Saturday, December 1st from 9am-6pm. Admission is \$5.00 per person.

The TVPC is NOT responsible for stolen, escaped or abandoned birds. Please make sure you have collected all of your birds at coop out.

NO ANIMALS ALLOWED IN SHOW HALL EXCEPT SERVICE DOGS! THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

PIGEON SHOW RULES

All birds must be seamless banded with bands from a recognized club. Split bands will be allowed, but birds must be entered as old birds, regardless of actual age.

All birds must be in good health. Any bird that is determined to not be in good health will be dismissed from the show.

Any faking or altering of the bird can result in dismissal by the judge.

Any substitutions must be made prior to the class judging.

All decisions of the judges will be final.

The host club has the authority to ask any exhibitor to remove his/her birds from the show.
